Coming from Brussels : Take E 19 / A1 direction Mechelen/Antwerp.

Approaching Antwerp, keep right in tunnel. Follow direction Breda.

On the ring R take **exit 3 Borgerhout** – Take left direction Antwerp Centrum/Singel =N 184/Luitenant Lippenslaan. Continue to center

Car Park : APCOA - Vestingstraat 49 (one direction street!)

Apcoa Car Park, entrance Vestingsstraat number 49. There you can take the elevator at the ground floor to the commercial center, you exit at the street De Keyserlei. Next to the exit, you enter the building on number 58 – 60.

Please take the elevator on the right to the 12th floor.
