Coming from Brussels : Take E 19

Approaching Antwerp, keep on the left lane in the tunnel. ("Craeybeckxtunnel")

Exit tunnel and follow straight ahead Generaal Lemanstraat till 3rd traffic light : take right and follow around Koning Albertpark - take left , favoring the right lane and take 3rd street right : Belgiëlei - Follow Belgiëlei till roundabout

On the roundabout take 3rd exit Charlottalei - continue to Quinten Matsijslei - continue till the park - take right Quelinstraat - take right Keizerlei.

Car Park : Qpark - Vestingstraat 13, 2018 Antwerp (one direction street!)

On Keizerlei, take right Appelmansstraat, then first street left = Vestingstraat. The Qpark is on your left hand side, just after the unloading bay of Mediamarkt

You can take the elevator in the Car Park to the commercial center, you exit at the street De Keyserlei.

Next to the exit, you enter the Multiburo office centre on number 58 – 60.

Please take the elevator on the right to the 12th floor.
